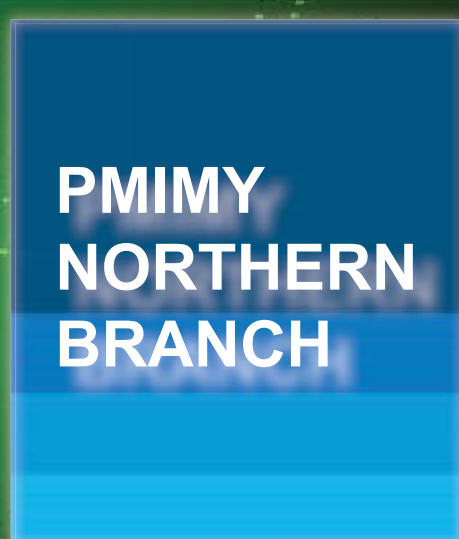

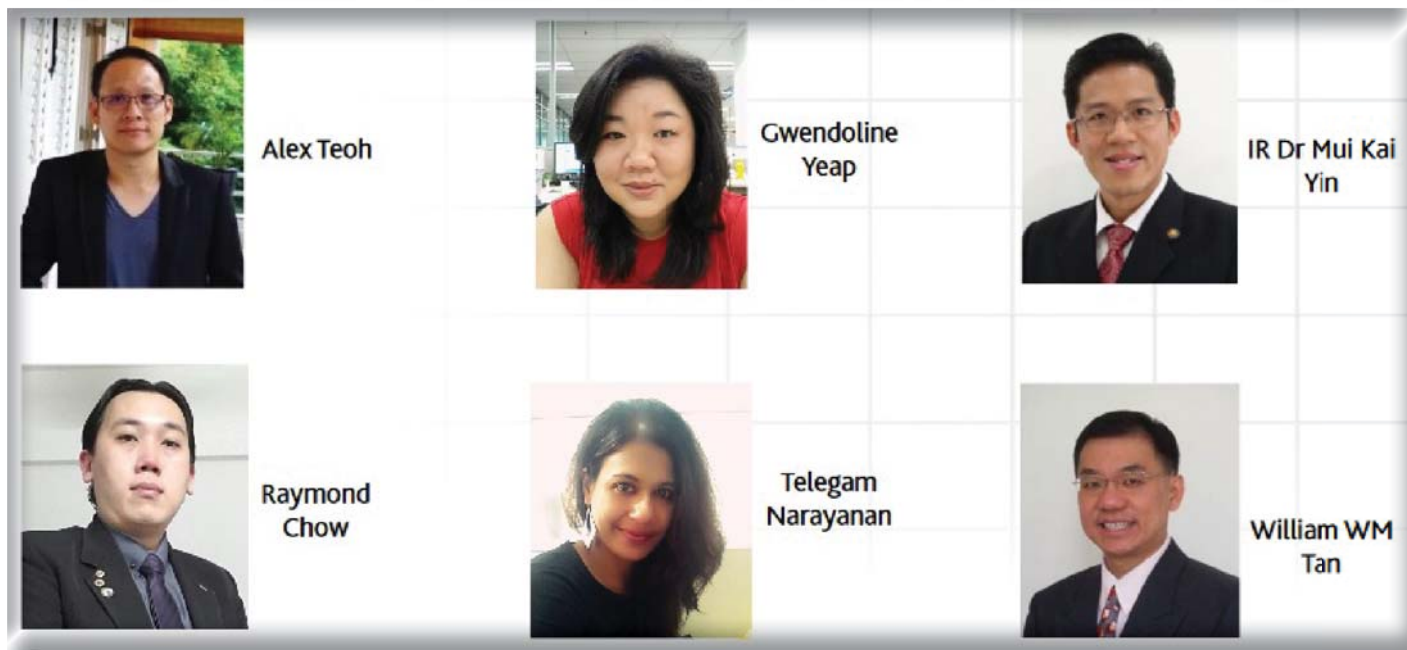

What triggered your involvement with PMIMY?

I joined PMI® since May 2009, passed my PMP® in July 2009 and eventually be part of PMIMY family in year 2011. However, I was hardly active in the chapter except participated 1 or 2 events once a year, and help to facilitated council elections during the AGM in 2014 and 2015.

Like many, I often wonder, apart from collecting PDUs, what else do I benefit from joining the local chapter? I then started my major shift in my life and seeing the importance of networking especially with my fellow peers outside my existing circle to keep me up-to-date on the profession. This idea was continued to be discussed with the PMIMY Council and we did a trial program by helping PMIEF™ to run a small workshop in WFUNA 2016 Youth Seminar in December 2016. This led to the creation of Director at-Large of Giving Back position in PMIMY. I was appointed to the position in January 2017 council meeting and eventually recommended to become PMIEF™ Liaison in Malaysia.

Two PMIEF programmes briefing were held in Kuala Lumpur and Penang on September and December 2017 respectively, and attended by over 80 project management professionals.
