

Learning in PMP Study Workshop



The workshop is created in response to the need for those who are pursuing PMP and CAPM exam. It was held at Level 8, HELP University, ELM Business School, Bukit Damansara, Kuala Lumpur. The workshop started on 9 July 2018 and will conclude on 19 January 2019. It is a guidance for examination format, agile practice, design of various questions and answer options including sharing of examination experiences.

The purpose of the workshop is to aid participants with useful studying tips and overcoming anxiety prior to sit for the examination. The course content includes mastering quick calculation, formula application, facts understanding, tackling the high probability and challenging topics such as Cost Management, Schedule Management, Risk Management which include techniques of identifying keywords in questions to find the most appropriate answer. Mr. Loga, one of the previous attendees of this workshop, shared that he has studied according to the tips provided in this workshop, which became a great help for him to pass the exam successfully. He also shared his personal experience in the exam hall in one of the workshops.
